INTRO & VISION

Surfrider Foundation is dedicated to the protection and enjoyment of the ocean, beaches, and waves through a powerful activist network. Surfrider Foundation Canada (SFC) has three chapters in British Columbia: the Vancouver Chapter, the Vancouver Island Chapter based in Victoria, and the Pacific Rim chapter based in Tofino and Ucluelet.

Each year since 2017, Surfrider Pacific Rim has worked with 15 diverse businesses in Tofino and Ucluelet on Vancouver Island to help them transform their current operations to eliminate unnecessary plastics, keep materials in use, divert waste from landfill, and implement regenerative practices.

Through this campaign, resources, innovative ideas and practices are gained from each business and shared with all participants, as well as the greater business community.

We hope for you to learn from our experience and insights gained from running this valuable and effective campaign, so that you can run a likewise or similar initiative in your community.





CAMPAIGN CRITERIA

Businesses must comply with the following:

- No use of expanded Polystyrene (aka Styrofoam) in operations, any other Styrofoam received is recycled in accordance with correct local practices.
- Business is not sending any recyclables to landfill, and recycling load will be reviewed by Surfrider volunteer at Sonbird.
- Complies with the single-use plastic regulation bylaws. In addition to polystyrene, this includes eliminating plastic cutlery for 2019/2020.
- Cigarette butts recycled (Hold on To Your Butt Campaign) and/or the business is declared a no smoking zone.
- Environmental sustainability incorporated into hiring process and training programs.

CAMPAIGN CRITERIA

And choose 5 out of the 9 optional criteria that the business is not already compliant with:

- 6) Addition of one more hard to recycle item to recycling practice.
- 7) Elimination of plastic water bottles, or another type of plastic bottle if this is already compliant.
- 8) Reusable tableware/packaging provided for guests, reusable containers provided for staff.
- 9) Elimination of plastic coffee cups and lids.
- 10) Elimination of one more type of single use plastic.
- 11) Mitigating microfibre pollution.
- 12) Implementation of a zero-waste or circular economic practice.
- 13) Donates 3 volunteer hours towards any other Surfrider campaign or program.
- 14) Wetsuits recycled (Wetsuit Reincarnation Program).



BULK PRODUCTS & REFILL OPTIONS

- Instead of single wrapped tea, opt for wholesale loose leaf.
- Instead of individually wrapped coffee bags or espresso pods, get your local coffee supplier to refill reusable containers or use the same refillable bags.
- Offer a water fountain on-site for guests to refill their bottle with.
- Ask your supplier to ship you bulk products over individually wrapped, and to eliminate plastic and styrofoam as much as possible from shipments.
- Switch from single-use soaps and amenities to refillable. Get in touch with your local refilleries and zero waste stories for partnerships.
- Opt for zero waste and plastic free products through bulk stories and zero waste stores.



COMMUNICATIONS TEMPLATE

SHARING ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY WITH GUESTS AND CUSTOMERS

Businesses have an opportunity to share their environmental practices and policies with guests, which will work to raise awareness with every person who interacts with their business. As a cafe, this might be in the form of a sign that lets people know policies on reusable mugs, or as a surf shop, putting up the Surfrider poster that explains wetsuit recycling. You can also add the Ocean Friendly Business logo and/or your certificate to your business website, along with all of your environmental initiatives.

Accommodation providers who have overnight guests often send a welcome email containing imperative information for the guest's stay. As an Ocean Friendly Business, this email can let guests know that Tofino and Ucluelet are on their way to becoming single-use plastic free towns. This email can instruct guests to bring their own reusable water bottles, mugs, straws and bags. In addition, it can let guests know that Tofino and Ucluelet has some of the cleanest drinking water in the province and suggest some environmental activities for guests to participate in!



OCEAN FRIENDLY TOWNS

What Businesses Can Do:

-Write to your Districts/City and let them know that your business supports banning single-use plastics.

 -Write a letter to the editor of your local or regional newspaper to let them know about the changes your business is making, how your supporting the movement to Rise Above Plastics, and how other businesses can get involved.

-Let suppliers know to not ship items with plastic or styrofoam, and request for them to provide bulk and refill options

-Organize a town or city cleanup, sponsor snacks and refreshments, and invite the community out! Record data of what you collect and share this with the media and local representatives.

-Find recycling/upcycling and composting solutions for all waste products created by your business
